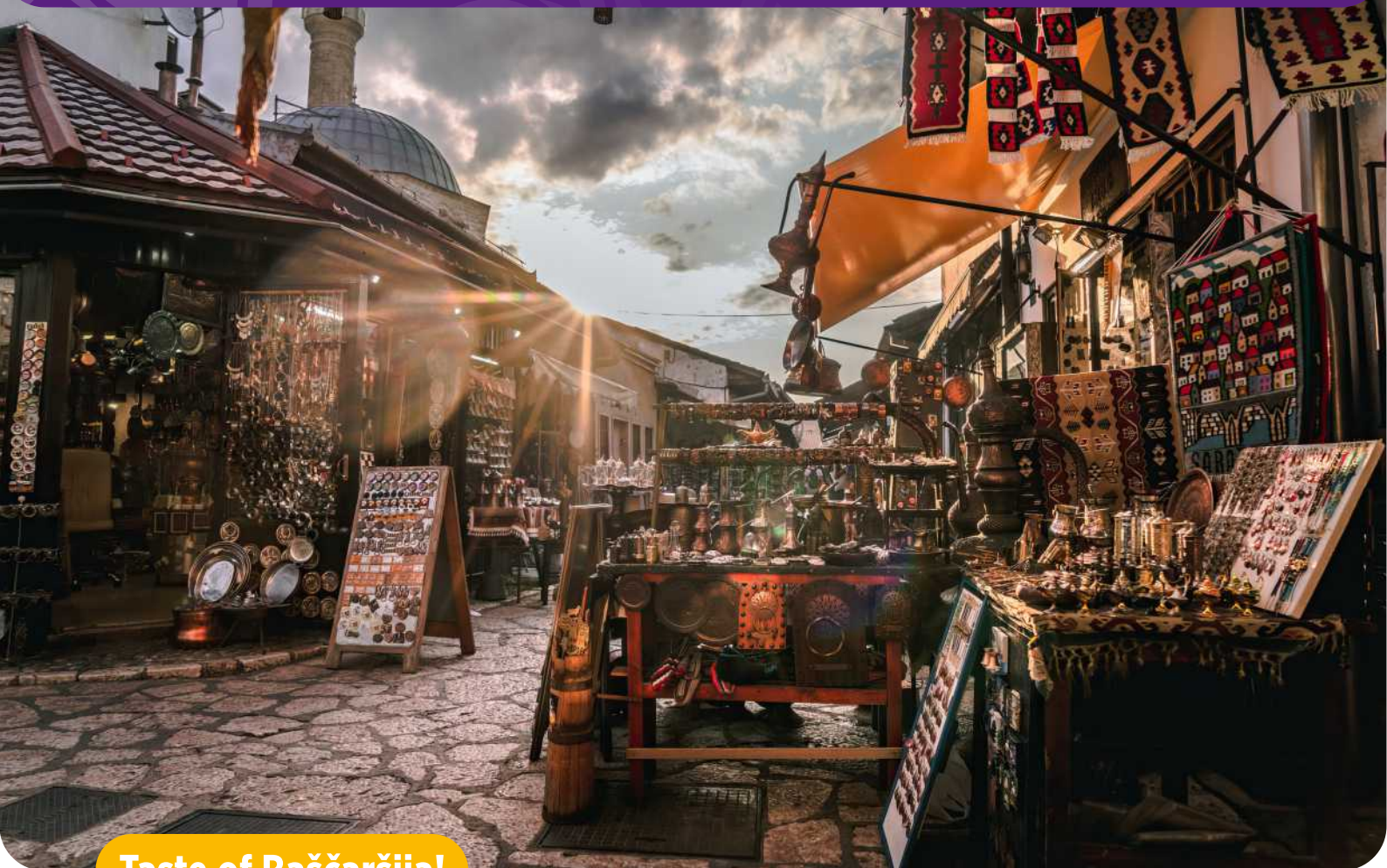

Experience the enchanting and addictive atmosphere of the city, rich in history and culture!

Baščaršija - the main attraction of Sarajevo and a favourite getaway spot of many

The main tourist attraction and the symbol of Sarajevo, Baščaršija, must be visited at least once in a lifetime!

This historic and cultural centre of Bosnia and Herzegovina's capital city was built during the 15th century, and it's situated on the northern coast of Miljacka.

Baščaršija was built in the 15th century and is located in the municipality of Stari Grad Sarajevo on the northern bank of the river Miljacka.

It reached its peak at the end of the 16th century, when there were as many as 80

different crafts organised into strong guilds, according to historical records.

Although the authorities have repeatedly wanted to turn it into a modern European city throughout history, fortunately in the end it did not go according to plan.

So, even today, a breath of history, a one-of-a-kind experience, and even more unique architecture await you in the heart of the city.

Try some unforgettable adrenaline attractions this summer!

Spring adventures and breathtaking views can be found in Romanija, specifically on the "Via Ferrata", a mountain climbing trail.

The trail on Crvene stijene will not disappoint even the most daring adventurers. This 350-meter-long trail features two suspension bridges as well as lookouts with benches that provide the best views in the area. Visitors can see falcons circling while climbing, hence the trail's name.

Visitors are provided with two ropes throughout the climb, and it is simple to climb with built-in steel equipment, so this trail is not only for hikers and climbers but for anyone who wants to try climbing and enjoy the beauty of this mountain. The guides who will accompany you on the trail will keep you safe, ensuring that this adventure will be one to remember!

It's worth noting that this experience is completely free, and you only need to make an appointment ahead of time. This area is located in eastern Sarajevo, making this exhilarating attraction suitable for a short trip from Sarajevo. 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Unforgettable adventure!

Kraljeva Sutjeska and Bobovac - home of Bosnian kings!

Learn about Bosnia and its history by visiting sites where Bosnian kings once resided.

This tour will take you from Kraljeva Sutjeska to Bobovac and will introduce you to a fascinating period of Bosnian history.

Begin your journey by visiting Kraljeva Sutjeska. This small town has a distinct charm. Visit St. John the Baptist's Franciscan monastery. Already in the monastery's surroundings, you'll notice a stone decoration with the Kingdom of Bosnia's coat of arms and a bronze statue of the last Bosnian queen, Katarina. The Museum of the Monastery of the King of Sutjeska is nearby and should not be missed..

In a rich collection of works of art, old objects of various kinds, weapons from

various historical periods, and a massive collection of thousands of books, the "crown jewels" are the incunabula, 22 of them, stand out as written evidence of this area's rich centuries-old history. Inquire with the monks about the museum's objects, the history of Bosnia and Herzegovina, and the monastery itself. After visiting the museum, proceed to Bobovac, once one of Bosnia and Herzegovina's most important fortifications. There are two ways to get to Bobovac. The walking tour from Kraljeva Sutjeska to Bobovac is one option, the more difficult and certainly more appealing to hikers and nature lovers.



The nearest Carwiz branch is located in Sarajevo, 65 km from Kraljeva Sutjeska.

Of course, driving from Kraljeva Sutjeska to Bobovac is another option. Bobovac was the best fortified mediaeval town in Bosnia, becoming the capital during the reign of Ban Stjepan II Kotromanić and remaining so until the Ottomans conquered Bosnian state independence in 1463. Bobovac was the key to the Bosnian kingdom, the administrative and military centre, and the location of the royal crown.

Today, Bobovac contains what remains of the former Bosnian kings' fortress, and in addition to the outlines of the walls, there is also a preserved stone house, a reminder of what Bobovac was in some ancient times. Bobovac is surrounded by beautiful nature, and the landscapes are spectacular. Take a look at this little place that will transport you to another time and imagine what it was like to live there during the reign of the Bosnian kings. You can visit the small tourist information centre, souvenir shop and stop for lunch made from local ingredients. Head to Kakanj from your nearest Carwiz office, and you'll be only 12 kilometres away from this magical, informative, and relaxing tour through the old royal residence!



Did you know?

In Kraljeva Sutjeska you can walk through the oldest house in central Bosnia, the traditional Bosnian house of Ivo Dusper. Today, the house from the earlier 18th century has been declared a national monument of BiH!

Banja Luka - cross the Vrbas via Dajak

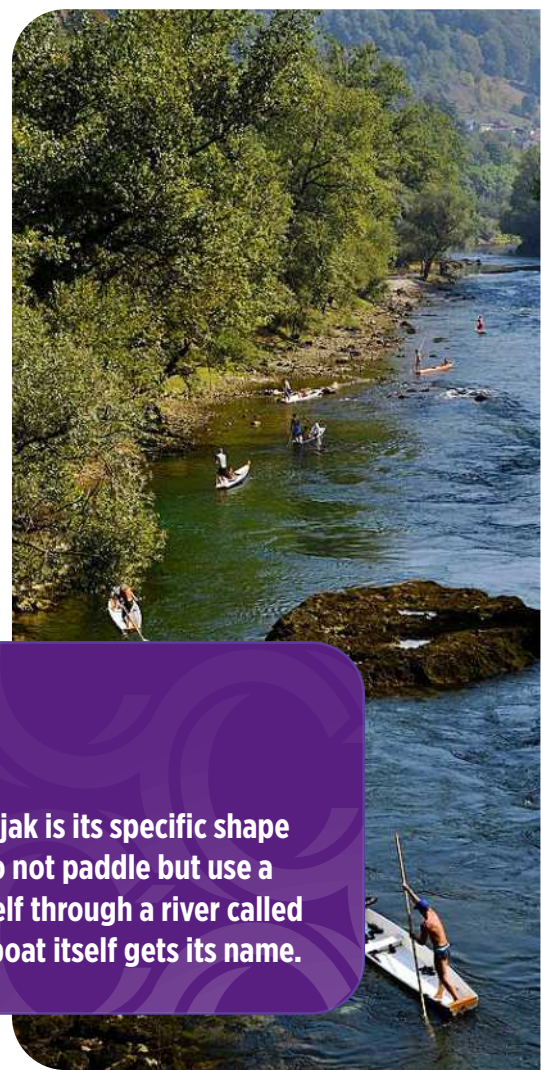
Banja Luka, the city on the Vrbas, is full of interesting and exciting things worth trying. One of these attractions is the Vrbas River itself.

The beautifully green Vrbas flows through the entire city, enhancing the sights of Banja Luka in all seasons. The arrival of nice weather provides an opportunity to get to know the Vrbas on a unique type of boat found only in Banja Luka.

The Dajak boat is one of the most famous sights in this city; its significance is demonstrated by the fact that it is as old as Banja Luka itself and that, at a time when there were no bridges in the city, it was the only way to cross from one Vrbas to another. Its unique shape is its

distinguishing feature. This unusually long boat, measuring slightly more than 7 metres in length, does not paddle. To move the boat, a pushing rod known as a dajak is used, after which the boat is named. It's also worth noting that the Dajak travels upstream. Because the Vrbas is mostly a shallow river, this is the best way to travel along it.

If you are heading to Banja Luka, don't forget to visit the Vrbas river and try the Dajak! Your Carwiz vehicle is ready to go!



Did you know?

The characteristic of Dajak is its specific shape and the fact that you do not paddle but use a stick for pushing yourself through a river called Dajak, after which the boat itself gets its name.

Discover the most beautiful small city in the world – Jajce!

One of Bosnia and Herzegovina's largest and most beautiful waterfalls!

Jajce is a town that, despite its population of only 30,000 people, can confidently claim to have everything! Jajce has many interesting museums in addition to being one of the cities with the most national monuments in BiH. That is certainly not all, because nature is unquestionably the most interesting and best that the city has to offer. It's interesting that the waterfall in Jajce was created more than 50,000 years ago and was named one of the world's 12 most beautiful, but what's even more interesting is that you won't have to leave town to see this 18-meter-high magnificent view. It's in the very city centre!

The famous Jajce fortress and the old town are located near the waterfall. According to legend, eggs were mixed into mortar to build this fortress, which is how Jajce (en. = egg) got its name. This fortress, which has been constantly rebuilt throughout history, has resisted the Ottomans for 65 years.



We must not forget to mention a tour of the old mills from the Ottoman Empire. These small mills, which were built to be used for flour production, are now a major tourist attraction and a BiH national monument.

Apart from the well-known waterfall, we probably all remember Jajce for hosting the II. session of the AVNOJ in 1943, during which Yugoslavia was formed. The Museum of the AVNOJ II Session is an interesting destination where you can find various records, objects, and

photographs, as well as the reconstructed AVNOJ session hall.

In addition to these main attractions, Jajce has a plethora of other unique and interesting attractions that make it an ideal day trip destination. Furthermore, it is only 70 kilometres from Banja Luka and 158 kilometres from Sarajevo!



Jajce is 71.5 km away from the Carwiz branch in Banja Luka and 122 km from the branch in Gradiška.

Popularly known as the "Krajiška ljepotica" or the beauty of Krajina, Kozara Mountain and its national park delight with their specialties in every season. With the arrival of spring, green and dense forest complexes and sunny meadows await adventurers seeking to immerse themselves in nature.

This is a place where you can breathe deeply and enjoy the beautiful atmosphere of the Kozara forests while participating in a variety of activities. Hiking, cycling, and rock climbing round out a stay at Kozara. The adventure park on Kozara is ideal for adrenaline junkies! Suspension bridges, ladders, zip lines, and polygons of varying difficulty provide an unforgettable adrenaline rush for both children and adults. Marked hiking trails offer an excellent opportunity to get to know this

mountain, enjoy its picturesque landscapes, and improve your psychophysical condition all at the same time.

The entrance fee to the Kozara National Park is 2KM for adults and 1KM for children, and the Adventure Park is KM for adults and 5KM for children. Kozara Mountain is a low mountain located between the Pannonian Plain and the Dinarides, and is surrounded by the rivers Sava, Una, Vrbas, and Sana. To get to the mountain, start your journey from the Carwiz Gradika office and you'll be on your way to an exciting adventure in just 40 minutes!



Kozara is 42.5 km away from the nearest Carwiz office in Gradiška.

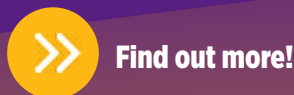

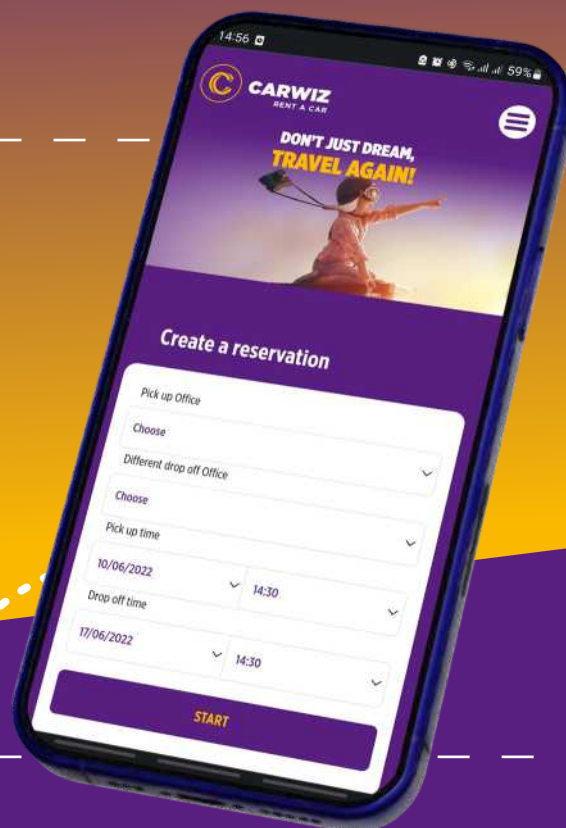
